## Warp Speed Registration

The 2010 Virginia Statewide Payroll Conference will be held in Portsmouth Virginia on October 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> at the beautiful Renaissance Portsmouth Hotel. The price will remain the same as last year, \$225.00 for local chapter members and \$275.00 for non chapter members. This is an opportunity to gain invaluable information to help you navigate those unknown galaxies threatening to overwhelm you on your travels through payroll compliance!

Registration opened May 3rd, 2010. Now is the time to approach your employer and make them aware of the value you will receive for two days of non-stop space travels!

You will have until August 20<sup>th</sup> to register at Warp Speed (early rate). All payments for early registration must be postmarked no later than August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Any registration with payment postmarked or received via paypal after this date will be charged the \$275.000 rate.

Sublight Speed registration (Regular) will continue through September 24<sup>th</sup>. All payments for regular registration must be postmarked or received via paypal no later than September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Any payment postmarked after this date will be assessed a \$50.00 late fee. Register and submit payment early for the best rate!

## PayPal Payment Option Now Available

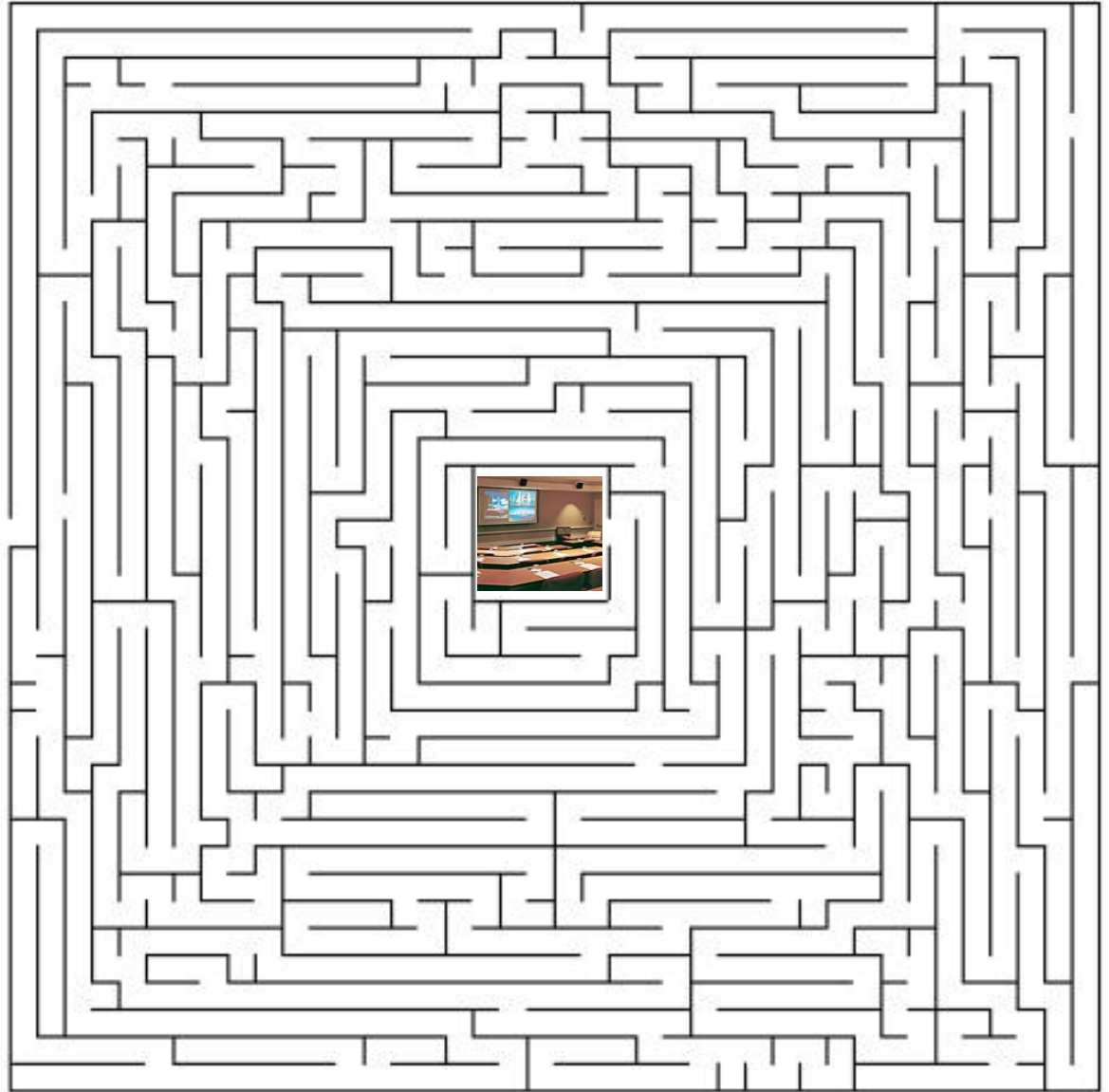

PayPal is a secure and fast method of paying your conference invoice. It is very simple and available to everyone. When you receive your invoice you will notice a button titled ~pay now~. ### Do You Have A Registration Confirmation?

We feel it is important to explain the VSPC registration process as well as provide a helpful tip on how to know if your registration was received and processed.

Attendees can register via the website, by faxing a completed registration form or by mailing a completed registration form along with payment. It is important to know no matter which method you elect to use for registration, you will get a confirmation e-mail and/or letter in addition to an invoice.
